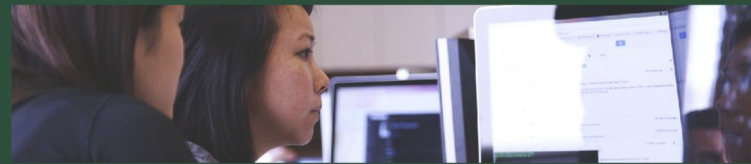

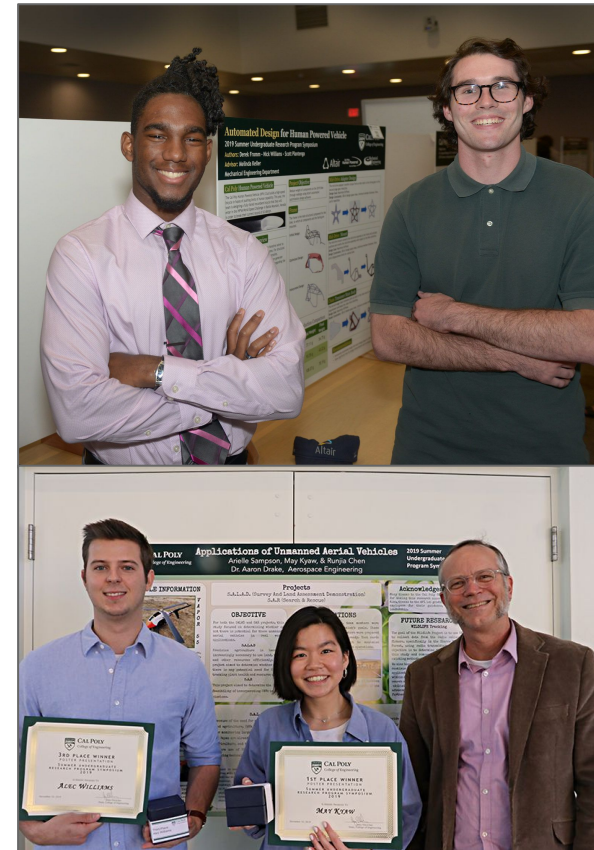

# Why Undergraduate Research?

- Undergraduate research is
  - “an inquiry or investigation conducted by an undergraduate that makes an original intellectual or creative contribution to [a] discipline” (Business Higher Education Forum, 2013, p. 2).
  - Open-ended & knowledge-generating
  - Mentored – individually and/or in a group
- **CENG students from all years and majors are encouraged to apply!**
- \$3,000 stipend for 8 weeks of research (approximately 20 hours per week)
