The Order of the Engineer is for graduating engineers who recognize the importance of ethics and responsibility in the engineering profession and choose to honor that through this self-selecting organization. A simple ceremony with your peers and the subsequent wearing of the Order of the Engineer ring signifies this to your engineering colleagues.



The deadline to complete the form is May 31st

Once you submit the form, the College will order your ring and certificate. To complete the process, please bring payment to the College of Engineering Dean's Office (192-301). The cost of the ring and certificate is \$12. Only cash and check will be accepted.

Rings and certificates will be distributed during the induction ceremony. There will be an Order of the Engineer induction ceremony coinciding with the Spring Cal Poly commencements. The ceremony will occur on June 13th at 11am in the ATL. Dates and time are subject to change.

We would like to acknowledge that this 'iron ring ceremony' has origins steeped in colonialism during a time when the field of engineering was not inclusive of all individuals. We have adopted the vision of the grass roots Canadian organization, 'Retool the Ring' to provide a ceremony that aligns with the evolution of present-day ethical perspectives as a profession and society. The Order of the Engineer is open to all engineering disciplines and inclusive to all engineers.
